A General Bequest designates a specific dollar amount; *A Specific Bequest* leaves specific property or belongings; *A percentage Bequest* is expressed as a percentage of an estate—as the value of the estate changes, so does the amount of the bequest; *A Residuary Bequest* leaves all or a portion of an estate after debts, taxes, expenses and other bequests have been paid.
