Special telecasts on EWTN, the 24-hour Catholic TV network, will include the Solemn Mass of the Assumption of Mary, live from the majestic Basilica of the National Shrine in Washington, D.C., Aug. 15 at 9 a.m. Another special program, "Interrupted Lives: Catholic Sisters Under European Communism" recounts the courage and deep faith of nuns who remained faithful to their vocations despite Soviet domination. It airs Aug. 14 at 11 p.m., Aug. 18 at 10 a.m. & Aug. 21 at 11 a.m. Also special telecasts on EWTN, will include "Mount St. Mary's University: The Spirit Continues." It details the rich history of this Catholic seat of learning, founded in 1808 and located outside Emmetsburg, Maryland, 12 miles from Gettysburg. It airs Aug. 22 at 7 p.m. & Aug. 24 at 10 a.m. "The Healing Prophet: Solanus Casey" tells the story of a humble Capuchin priest in the New York City & Detroit areas who was sought out by thousands for spiritual advice before his death in 1957 at age 86.
